


COVID-19 GUIDANCE | ENGLISH 19-07-2021

On 19 July 2021 the Government removed almost all COVID-19 restrictions across England.



It is still important to practise good hygiene and wash your hands often

The rules on self-isolation have also changed.



If you are under 18 or are fully vaccinated against COVID-19 you DO NOT have to self-isolate if you have been in contact with someone who tests positive



BUT you are advised to take a PCR test as soon as possible and wear a mask around other people while you wait for your test result.





If you are not fully vaccinated, you must still self-isolate for 10 days if you have been in close contact with someone who tests positive for COVID-19 or if YOU test positive.

How to get a vaccine

If you are 18 or over and would like to get a vaccine, you can go to vaccination centre without an appointment. This is called a walk-in centre. To find out where and when these are in Surrey go to www.surreyheartlandsccg.nhs.uk/covid-19/coronavirus-covid-19-vaccination-centres
